

WHERE IS LAMPETER?

By Car

Lampeter is approximately 45 minutes from the M4 between Carmarthen and Aberystwyth. The University of Wales is situated in the centre of the town on the A485 (towards Tregaron). There is ample parking at several car parks behind the college.

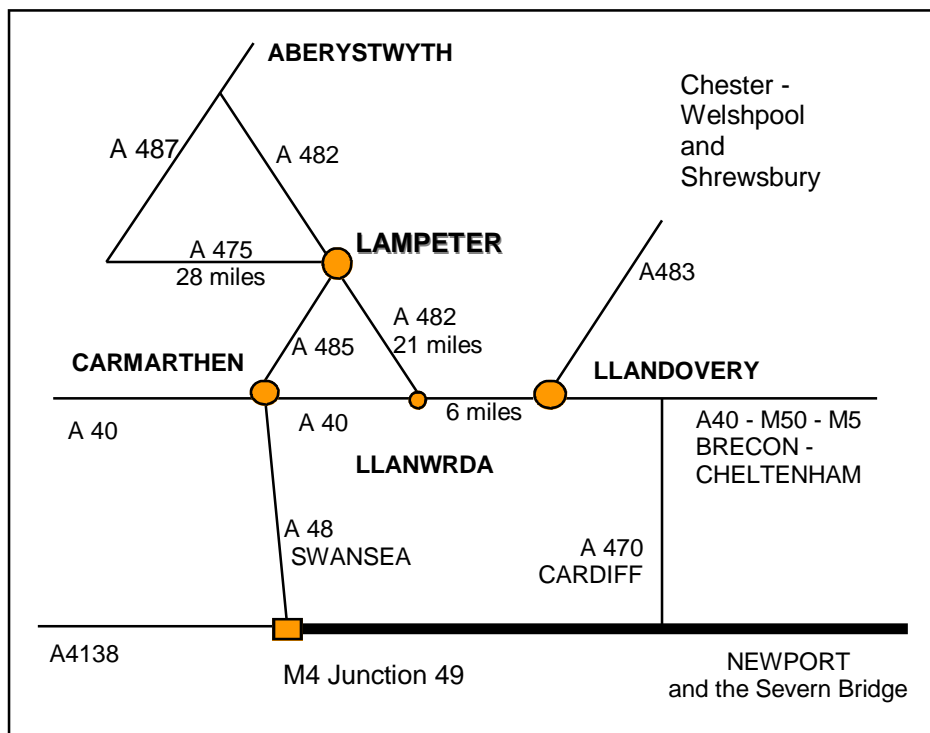
By Rail

The nearest railway stations are at Carmarthen or Aberystwyth. Bus services from each of these stations (and Swansea) serve Lampeter. It is usually easier to travel from the south and west of England via Swansea.

By Coach

The TrawsCambria bus service links Bangor, Aberystwyth and Lampeter from the north and Cardiff, Swansea, Carmarthen and Lampeter from the south east. Information on the current timetable from Traveline 0870 608 2608 and the web address is www.traveline-cymru.org.uk.

GUEST SPEAKERS and PRESENTATIONS
SUNDAY 5th SEPTEMBER

MARGARET COLLIS Hon. EFIAP APAGB DPAGB ARPS

Margaret joined her first club in the Seventies, the Kingswood Photographic Society. At this time she took mainly slides, but soon moved to Cibachrome printing and enjoyed derivative techniques in black and white as well. Landscape photography has always been her preferred interest, but graphic subjects also appeal to her.

Joining the WCPF Executive in about 1984 as Exhibition Secretary, Margaret eventually became their President and representative to the PAGB. During this time she joined Images sans Frontieres and met many fellow photographers in neighbouring Europe, helped by the fact that she had taught French and German and lived in each of those countries for a year. It was this contact that led to Margaret being invited to join the FIAP Directory Board.

This led to her first visit to the Far East when the FIAP Congress was held in China and she found this a fascinating experience. In 2008, she visited Vietnam and Cambodia and found them equally fascinating. She has become more interested in travel photography and in the people she has encountered during her travels. She has found that there are always new facets of photography to explore.

DIANNE OWEN FRPS

Many people have asked Dianne where she gets her ideas for her images. It really began when she was young and made shapes and patterns with paper and paints, and sorted bobbins of coloured cottons into the shades and colours of the rainbow.

Along with these early experiments, Dianne had always taken photographs of her family and the things around her, and her uncle had shown her how to make mono prints in the dark-room. All these experiences, combined with an inspirational talk by Rikki O'Neill at Southport Photographic Society, led to Dianne realising what she wanted to do with her photography.

Still Life is a favourite of Dianne's as it is easier to fit in to the limited time she has available, and in addition, the digital age has allowed the creative process to be a lot quicker than her previous dark-room methods. Joining Southport Photographic Society was the first step on a fascinating journey, taking Dianne from her first entry into a club competition, through national and international exhibitions, to achieving her Associateship and Fellowship of the Royal Photographic Society in 2008.

GRAHAM SERGEANT FRPS

Graham started out as an academic Sociologist, but for most of his working life he was involved professionally in photography, firstly as a documentary film director. During this period he met and filmed Grand Admiral Karl Donitz, the German U-boat supremo who, for three weeks, was Hitler's successor. Graham was then involved in audio-visual presentations, followed by 25 years of wedding and social photography. To end his career, Graham returned to TV programme production and before retiring, his Company produced three programmes for Sky Sports featuring Nigel Mansell, the former Formula One racing driver.

Since retiring from North London to the South Coast, Graham has indulged his passion for social documentary photography and photo-journalism, using black and white film printed in his traditional darkroom. Now a member of Chichester Camera Club, Graham gained his LRPS in 2002, his ARPS in 2003 and his FRPS in 2006 and 2008.
